Tristan\* is pretty much a loner. He is a good thinker and fairly bright when it comes to school, but he doesn't have any focus in his life. He drifts on a troubled sea from one thing to another, and even we only see him sporadically.



Tristan needs Jesus in his life. In this troubled culture that pushes kids to be better than everyone else, and yet rewards them for doing next to nothing; he feels the pressure to prove himself, but without focus and an anchor, this is impossible to do.

While it has been a very active year of ministry, our finances have not kept up.
